Daily Supported Reading (DSR)

DSR is a well-established approach at Holmleigh Primary School to the teaching of early reading. This whole class-based programme is delivered initially to Year 1, then introduced into Reception and for some children in Year 2 who continue to benefit from DSR for maximum impact across the school. Additionally, DSR is implemented in small groups or 1-1 catch up interventions across the school where needed. Children enjoy daily independent reading in small groups matched to their independent reading level, led by a trained adult.

Adults use differentiated lesson guides to move children on and make sound judgements about when to do so.

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The programme used with synthetics phonics helps children make accelerated progress in raising school reading standards at KS1.

The programme is designed so that children become fluent readers. Children:

- read stories on their own from the start
- learn to respond to and engage with new ideas and information
- are taught how to access information with increasing autonomy
- learn to problem solve independently while keeping a story or message in mind
