In **Literacy** this half term, we have been writing calligrams and shape poems. A calligram is a word or piece of text in which the design and layout of the letters creates a visual image related to the meaning of the words themselves. We really enjoyed writing shape poems about spring. We then performed our poems to the class and made sure to use loud clear voices, expression and actions whilst performing.
