






We have been reading Norse Myths by Kevin Crossley-Holland in our Destination Reader Sessions and have focused on the key reading skills such as inference and clarifying. We


have even made Viking Bread!





In **Literacy** we have been learning about adverts and focused on the key grammar of comparative and superlative adjectives, modal verbs and the subjunctive. We have produced our own adverts inspired by book characters.

In Maths we have been focusing on place value and we have been reading and writing numbers to one million, rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10,000, and 100,000. We have revised Roman Numerals and have worked on counting from positive numbers through to negative numbers and solving sums that involve negative numbers.



In Science we are looking at Forces. We learnt a lot during our trip to the Science Museum. The show was amazing and jam-packed with important science knowledge and vocabulary. We have followed in the footsteps of Galileo by finding out if mass affects the rate of descent for various sized objects. We have also explored air resistance and friction by conducting experiments with parachutes and different materials.



In Art the children have worked on their drawing skills and have produced fantastic drawings of Viking long ships. They have also designed and made their own Viking shields.

In RE the children have been learning about Christianity with Miss Siddiqui.
