



## Register of interests for Holmleigh School Governors 2023-24

The decision-making processes of the school should be conducted, and seen to be conducted, in an objective and unbiased manner. Governors and school staff have a responsibility to avoid any conflict between business and personal interests and the interests of the federation or its schools. To help put this duty into practice and to meet legal requirements, all schools maintain a register of pecuniary (financial) and business interests. The register will ensure that governors' and staff members' personal interests do not unfairly prejudice, influence or conflict with the decision-making processes of the school. or its schools. The school is also required to publish the date its governors were appointed and the length of their term of office.

The governing board shall consist of 3 parent governors, 1 LA governor, 1 staff governor, 1 headteacher, 6 co-opted governors. Total number of 12.
