<b>Week beginning:</b>	<b><u>Focus Word</u></b>	<b><u>Story/Activity</u></b>
19.02.2024	Meesha Makes Friends	Story about the joys and difficulties of making and keeping friends.
26.02.2024	What the Curriculum Committee do.	An assembly lead by the Curriculum Committee on their role and what they have done so far.
04.03.2024	Worries	Book about the kinds, worries, and anxieties facing many children today and explores how their fears might be overcome.
11.03.2024	Problem solving ( friendships)	The Boys
18.03.2024	Sharing assembly History/Geography focus	A celebration assembly- 3 children from each class (R- Year6) to share work that they are proud in History/Geography
25.03.2024	Sharing assembly History/Geography focus	A celebration assembly- select some children to share work that they are proud of or targets that they have managed to reach / on the way to reaching.
