We have enjoyed a very busy and action-packed half term!

In science we learnt all about the phases of the Moon during our visit to Our Lady's Secondary School. We experimented with a lamp (the Sun), a tennis ball (the Moon) and ourselves as the Earth and observed how the Moon appears to change shape.

Year 5 also visited the Planetarium at the Greenwich Observatory to enjoy the show and explore our solar system. Starting from the Planetarium, we were transported to a special view of the Earth from space to see how it moves, before traveling a bit further away, to explore the Moon and its lunar phases. We became astro-navigators, viewing the constellations, and using Polaris to find the direction of north. We flew out to view the Solar System, visiting a rocky planet, the asteroid belt, an outer planet, and dwarf planets in the Kuiper Belt. Venturing even further out, we were introduced to extrasolar planets, before being wowed by our stunning Milky Way Galaxy and its place in the local Universe. On the DLR, Mahir got to press the button to sound the horn and Maya made an announcement over the tannoy!






