Focus books this half term...

In Reception, we read the story The Paper Dolls. We engaged in role-play to re-enact the story, helping us build confidence in retelling it. We also explored new vocabulary such as 'gnashing,' 'curious,' 'irritated,' and 'fed up' to create our own versions of the story.

Chinese New Year

Maths

Capacity

We explored the concept of capacity and learned how to describe how much a container could hold. We used language such as: full, empty, half-full, half-empty, nearly full, and nearly empty. Then we compared capacity by arranging containers in order from empty to full.



Mass

We looked at mass and measured objects using a balance scale. We discussed how we knew which objects were heavier, lighter or the same.
