

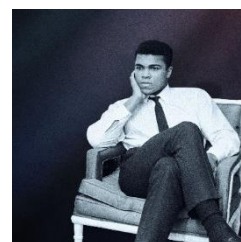

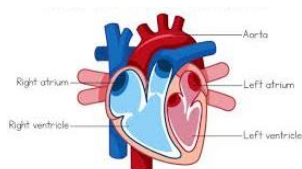
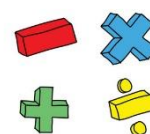
Year 6's Newsletter Autumn 1 2025

In **Literacy**, we got to know each other by sharing our life stories through the writing of an autobiography and they really improved over the course of the unit. They have since moved on to writing biographies about Muhammad Ali. This unit will conclude after the half term break before moving on to narratives.



In **Reading**, they have thoroughly enjoyed reading 'Who Let The Gods Out?' by the fantastic Maz Evans which ties in perfectly with their History topic - The Ancient Greeks. During their Destination Reader lessons, they have supported their understanding by consistently applying a range of skills and strategies.

In **Maths**, they started by making sure their foundations were solid by looking at the place value of numbers before moving on to learn about the four operations - addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. After the half term, they will build on what they have learned and begin a unit on fractions.



In **Science**, they have been learning all about the circulatory system. They have learned about the structure of the heart, the function of blood and the different types of blood vessels. They conducted an experiment to investigate how the size of a blood vessel affected the speed at which blood flows.

In **History**, they have been learning about Ancient Greece. They learned about different aspects of Ancient Greek life, such as religion, the systems of government and the introduction of democracy. They used a range of sources to make comparisons between the Spartans and the Athenians. They also used their artistic skills to design Greek pots.



This half term, they were also lucky enough to take part in an **Art** workshop. They studied how the features of the face are measured and positioned, and then applied their knowledge to draw fantastic self-portraits.
