Every week the nursery listen to different music from around the world. Every child has a turn to talk about their family and where they come from. This is celebrated and music is chosen to listen to which reflects the country.

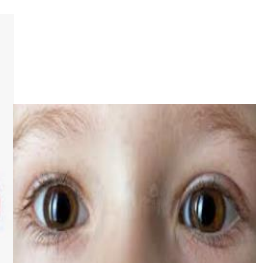
Patterns... Are all around us

The nursery have been looking for patterns around them. They have made their own repeat pattern and are learning to recognise the unit of repeat in a pattern. Have a look at some of the patterns they have made.



Phonics- Drumming are us!

This half term the nursery have been learning about instrumental sounds. They have learnt the names of familiar percussion instruments and how to play them. The children explored making their own sound makers using a range of materials. They performed to nursery rhymes using instruments with our specialist music teacher: Miss Kate. They also had an opportunity to play a real drum!

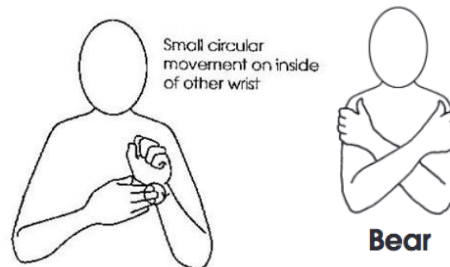
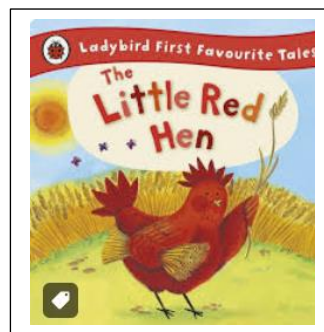
Communication and Language- Brown Bear, Brown Bear

Our next story in the Spring term will be:

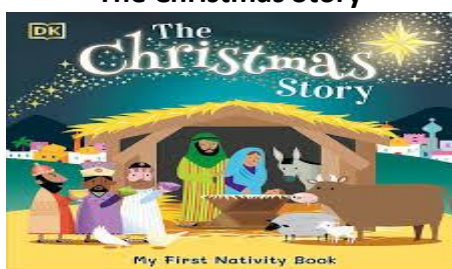
The Little Red Hen
