Focus books this half term...

In Reception, we read the story *Stuck in the Mud*. We enjoyed listening to and re-telling the story using a story map, which helped us understand what happens on a farm. We also learned how bread is made and identified the ingredients needed to make our own bread. Through our learning, we discovered how teamwork on a farm helps people work together and build friendships.



## Phonics

In Phonics, we continued learning our Phase 2 sounds. We have started to segment and blend sounds to read words. We have also been practising correct letter formation.

We learnt how to keep ourselves safe when crossing the road. We had a special visitor who led a workshop and taught us how to stay safe near roads.

We explored the importance of keeping our teeth healthy. We learnt how to brush our teeth properly and how often we should brush them.



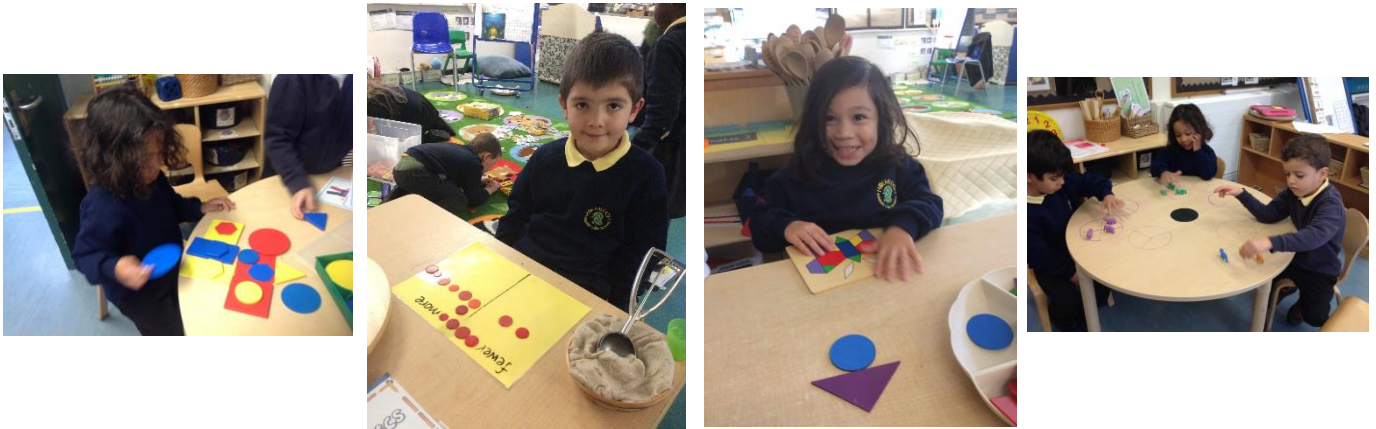
## Materials
