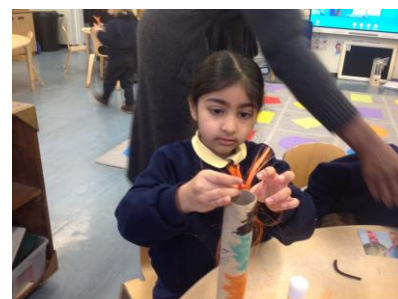

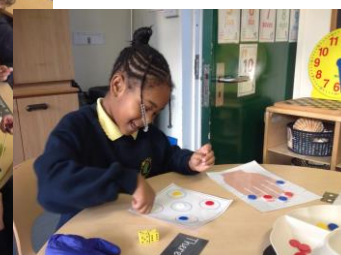


Phonics

In Phonics, we have continued learning our Phase 2 sounds and have now begun to introduce Phase 3 sounds. The children have been practising segmenting and blending sounds to read words, as well as working on correct letter formation.

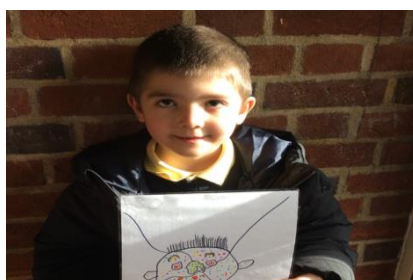
Maths

In Maths this half term, we have been focusing on number composition and partitioning numbers within 5. We explored how smaller numbers can "hide" within larger numbers and how different parts combine to make a whole.
